Student Makes \$25,000 in Donations to Bellevue Schools Foundation

Her non-profit, Science For Community, has contributed to BSF for six years



BELLEVUE, Wash. - The Bellevue Schools Foundation announced it received a total of \$25,000 of donations from a Bellevue School District student, Kosha Upadhyay, over the last six years. The funding comes from her non-profit, Science for Community and her signature event call Buzz

Buzz Bowl is a Jeopardy-style buzzer game to make learning science and math fun for 5th-8th graders. As Upadhyay explains, "We recruit and train about 80 student volunteers and over 1000 volunteer hours are given away. Around 200 other students are initiated into our novel way of learning STEM at every event. We usually have around 50 teams that occupy an entire middle school. Every event uses 400 questions spanning subjects such as math, physics, chemistry, biology, earth science, and astronomy. In one event around 200 matches are played and 10,000 questions are asked within 4-5 hours. Scores and results of all 200 rounds are triple-checked and computed using an automated system within 10-20 minutes to determine the winners."

"So far Buzz Bowl has helped create a strong community of over 2000 STEM enthusiasts across 60 schools with the help of over 600 high school
