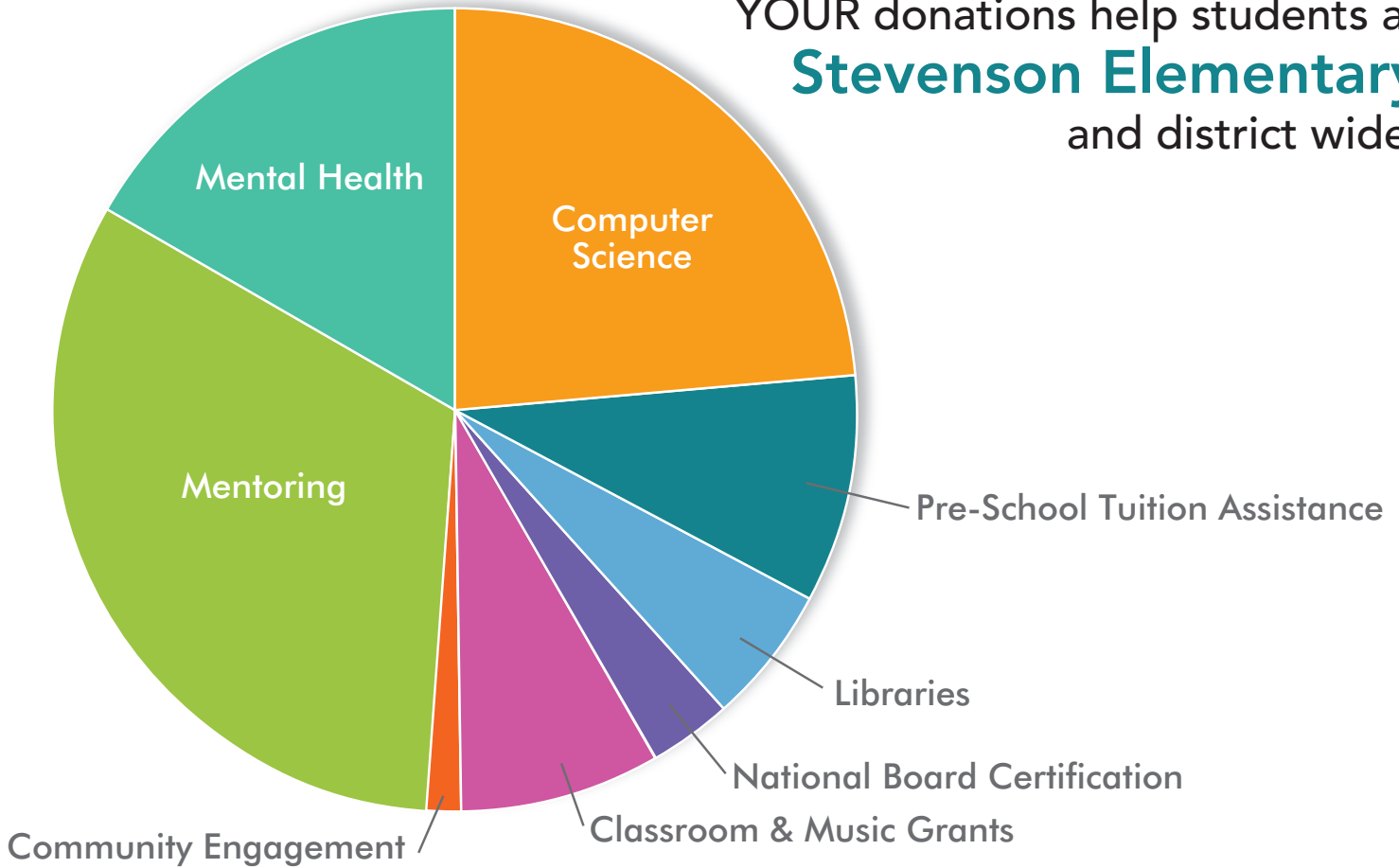




Bellevue Schools Foundation, will invest **\$1 MILLION** in our schools this year!

- Local toymaker, Rick Hartman created an educational and entertaining math-based learning experience.
- The Salmon in Schools program provided salmon eggs to K-5th grade students.
- Students grades 3-5 were offered an after school choir opportunity.
- Inspiring visits from local authors empowered students K-5 to see themselves in books.
- 4th graders learned stories of Washington and the Snoqualmie Tribe through a traveling museum.
- A theatrical performance in each 3rd grade class of an immigrant family's experience at Ellis Island.
- A theatrical performance in each 4th grade class on the impact of the gold rush on the Pacific Northwest.
- A theatrical performance in each 5th grade class on the experience of a Black soldier in the American Revolution.
